
Düsseldorf is a cosmopolitan, international metropolis. It is evident in the many ways the city on the Rhine cultivates a tolerant and hospitable way of life. Locals and visitors alike come together on the steps at the Burgplatz for example. It is a gorgeous spot on the river banks, perfect for enjoying the sunset and the impressive Rhine panorama.

Perfect connectivity

Düsseldorf is a "ten-minute" city. It takes only ten minutes to walk from the renowned shopping locations on Königsallee to the Rhine embankment. The train journey from the main railway station to Düsseldorf Airport is also only a matter of minutes. From there, one can reach almost every point in Europe in two hours. That makes Düsseldorf the ideal starting point for exploring Europe.



The short distances are an obvious advantage: from Dubai to Düsseldorf in six hours, for example; Moscow-Düsseldorf in three hours. At the same time, Düsseldorf's guests value is its superb location in western Europe. This makes it the ideal base for exploring. It's just a one-hour flight to leading cities such as London, Amsterdam or Paris. By car, it's only a three-hour drive from Düsseldorf to Amsterdam, Brussels and Luxembourg.



Düsseldorf itself is a real "10-minute" city: the trip between most health facilities and the city centre takes only ten minutes. The city's excellent infrastructure ensures that it is only ten minutes from airport to city centre as well. Thanks to its great transport links and their high frequency, Düsseldorf has a great appeal for business and leisure travellers alike.



Metropolis on the Rhine

A famous Frenchman visited Düsseldorf over 200 years ago. On seeing the beautiful city, Napoleon gasped: "C'est petit Paris." Today, Little Paris has become a dynamic yet manageably sized metropolis with international flair.

Today, the state capital Düsseldorf is home to over 600,000 very contented inhabitants – because the Rhine metropolis regularly ranks among the leading cities in international quality-of-life surveys. The combination of diverse cultural options, the region's excellent leisure amenities, fantastic international cuisine, many leading companies and its central location in the heart of Europe make Düsseldorf the perfect place to live. That goes not only for locals but, of course, also for our many visitors.

The city on the Rhine features short distances, a gigantic range of different shops, first-class hotels, award-winning restaurants, a hospitable atmosphere and all the charms a big city has to offer with none of the frantic bustle. If one nonetheless needs a little break, a stroll along the Rhine embankment promenade is the ideal way to relax. It offers a panoramic view of the mighty, meandering river with its three great bridges. Back in the Altstadt (Old Town), one can dive back into the lively cheer of Rhenish joie de vivre. Every conceivable delicacy is on sale at the market on Carlsplatz. Just a stone's throw away from here is the world-famous shopping street, Königsallee. It is home to international luxury labels and exclusive boutiques as well as art galleries, illustrious hotels and cafés.

Art and culture play a special role in Düsseldorf. The Kunstakademie was founded in 1773. Artists such as Joseph Beuys, Gerhard Richter and Andreas Gursky studied and taught here. Meanwhile, the Kunstsammlung NRW art collection offers world-class exhibitions and the Museum Kunstpalast shows paintings by artists ranging from Rubens to Kandinsky. The Deutsche Oper am Rhein guarantees an outstanding opera experience, while the Tonhalle is home to the Düsseldorf Symphony Orchestra. Those who prefer it a little quieter can visit Schloss Benrath (Benrath Palace), a rococo gem with an imposing park. The MedienHafen features exciting modern architecture, most notably the striking buildings designed by Frank O. Gehry, who was also responsible for the Guggenheim Museum in Bilbao.

The Altstadt (Old Town) has always been Düsseldorf's heart. In the narrow lanes of the city centre, there is a vibrant sense of life and happiness. This tiny part of the city is jam-packed with bars, fashion boutiques, art museums and Düsseldorf's famous "Altbier" breweries.

The Altstadt (Old Town) is also traditionally known as the "longest bar in the world" – not, as many outsiders think, to be found in one single pub. In fact, this term describes an entire microcosm that takes in over 260 hostelries, bars and restaurants in Düsseldorf's Altstadt (Old Town). It has already been a melting pot of all social classes for centuries.

People most enjoy coming together at Düsseldorf's traditional brewery inns for a tasty Altbier. This dark, top-fermented beer is still brewed in the rear courtyards of the Altstadt (Old Town), exactly as it was 100 years ago. So it's a craft beer that existed long before the supposed reinvention of artisanal brewing. It is made with the best ingredients, in small batches and with a great deal of love. Incidentally, brewery inn guests are not served by a waiter but by a Köbes. Initially, a Köbes can seem a little brusque, but it's all just part of the fun. And another little tip: the Köbes will continue bringing fresh beer until you cover your glass with your beer mat. Those who start feeling a little hungry in the Altstadt (Old Town) really don't need to worry because the narrow streets contain many cosy restaurants, while on Carlsplatz, there are lots of food stalls offering culinary specialities. There is something for every taste here, from a Rhenish soup kitchen to handmade pasta and unusual steak specialities to magnificent patisserie. Apart from that, the market sells traditional products such as brushes and baskets as well as gorgeous flowers, and also has wonderful fruit and veg stalls.

Those who prefer a shopping experience with a modern and trendy vibe will love Flinger Straße and Mittelstraße, which are lined with international fashion brands. There is something for everybody here, be it leather shoes, bags, trainers, hip streetwear or cosmetics. The quiet part of the otherwise bustling Altstadt (Old Town) is at the northern end. On peaceful Stiftsplatz in front of St. Lambertus Church, there it feels like going back in time to the days when Düsseldorf still was truly a village.

There are few shopping streets in Germany whose names are as resonant and legendary as Königsallee. Framed by overhanging plane trees, the grand Kö boulevard is lined with luxury boutiques, shopping malls and elegant hotels.

At one time, the Kö was known as Kastanienallee because it was lined with magnificent chestnut trees. However, in 1848 the King of Prussia, Frederick William IV, announced a visit to Düsseldorf – then a quite sleepy town. Enraged by what they saw as unjust Prussian edicts, the populace gave the king an anarchic welcome – pelting him with horse dung. One such missile is even said to have actually hit his coat. To restore the city to the king's good graces, Kastanienallee was swiftly renamed "Königsallee" (King's Avenue).

Today, the Kö is one of Europe's leading luxury shopping streets and, measuring 87 metres across, it is also Germany's widest street. There are many French and Italian fashion and couture houses here, particularly at the upper end of the Kö. Fashionistas will find every luxury brand that their hearts could possibly desire. One can also soak up the Kö's distinctive charm at one of the many outdoor cafés. Simply take a seat, order a latte or a sundae, and watch people strolling past. Then it's almost like a fashion show. At the northern end, you will come to magnificent Corneliusplatz, the opera house and Hofgarten – Germany's oldest public park. These delights are followed by the Kö-Bogen, an architectural highlight. The building, designed by star architect Daniel Libeskind, is another shopping temple with many international brands and sublime gastronomy. At the same time, this ensemble forms the end of the splendid boulevard.

Königsallee is not only a street for taking a stroll, however – during the summer months it is constantly changing. It is namely here in the shadow of the overhanging plane trees that the "Bücherbummel" (Book Fair), the Gourmet Festival and sporting events such as the "Rund um die Kö" bicycle race or the marathon take place. Königsallee also has much to offer in cultural terms, as it is home to high-calibre galleries, which exhibit art by world-famous artists. The whole world of art is on display here, from the works of the old masters to modern classics and from abstract expressionism to contemporary art.



Violern <u>Medechen-Jafen</u>

The rehabilitation of the old port is one of Düsseldorf's most spectacular projects. Over the last 30 years star architects such as Renzo Piano, Helmut Jahn, David Chipperfield and Frank Gehry have left an indelible mark on the city's skyline with their distinctive and modern building.

What makes the MedienHafen special is its architectural diversity, which establishes a creative connection with the river and the shipping industry. The buildings have distinctive names such as Wolkenbügel (Cloud Hanger), Sign! or The Living Bridge.


One of the most beautiful viewing points in Düsseldorf is Pebble's Terrace, behind which one can see the luxury Hyatt Hotel. You can take a seat here beside the UFO-like pavilion – clad with aluminium shingles – and drink a sundowner. A true premium spot where you can enjoy an unobstructed view of the city and the river. The Gehry buildings are extremely popular with Instagrammers, photographers and photography courses. In fact, there is always someone taking a picture here. The three swaying towers in white, silver and red are the most eye-catching feature of the MedienHafen. Tilted walls, warped towers, windows canted within the walls – every detail is worth a photo. The Californian architect Frank O. Gehry, who previously designed the spectacular Guggenheim Museum in Bilbao, bestowed a magnificent gift on Düsseldorf. The ensemble – mainly home to advertisers, lawyers and architects – is known as the Neuer Zollhof. Düsseldorf's marina is located to the front in the harbour basin. As everywhere else in Düsseldorf, art is not far away either. In a former warehouse at Kai 10, the Arthena Foundation offers an ambitious exhibition programme featuring young, international art.

The best view of Düsseldorf and the surrounding region is from the Rheinturm (Rhine tower). The city's highest building at 240.5 metres stands at the entrance to the MedienHafen. Apart from its viewing platform, it also houses a restaurant. The view can be enjoyed from every angle because a mechanism allows the restaurant to rotate 360 degrees every 72 minutes. There are also many restaurants and bars below at the harbour basin ranging from vegetarian to French bistro cuisine to burger joints. One particular highlight is the Restaurant Lido Hafen, housed in a glass cube in the middle of the harbour basin.

Rococo in Benrath

Schloss Benrath (Benrath Palace) is a real gem. This enchanting rococo pleasure palace is an ensemble of palace, lakes and a beautiful park. Visitors are strongly recommended to talk a stroll through the park, soaking up the rococo splendour.

Elector Karl Theodor had the hunting and garden palace built in Benrath between 1755 and 1773. The aim of creating an overall composition of architecture, landscaping, garden art and sculpture is typical of the rococo period just before the transition to neoclassicism. The palace a distinctive example of its kind as very few baroque and rococo palaces were built in this region. The architect was Nicolas de Pigage, the "intendant of the gardens and waterworks" at the Mannheim royal court. The palace's magnificent exterior is best seen from the city side.

The central building – the corps de logis – housed the living quarters of the elector and his wife. From the outside, the single-storey structure seems almost modest. Behind the façade, however, one will discover a sophisticated, cleverly structured system of 80 rooms, two atriums and seven staircases, spread over four floors. This produces a surprising effect as was particularly popular in architecture, landscaping and garden art of the time. The idea was that visitors would only notice the spaciousness and grandeur when they entered. Guided tours of the corps de logis are available. Guests are only permitted to enter wearing felt slippers in order to protect the extremely valuable flooring, which is also fun to slide on.

The world's first Museum of Garden Art has been housed in the east wing since 2002. In summer, the inner courtyard, with its collection of ancient citrus trees, is a lovely place to relax for a while. The great palace garden is worth a visit at any time of the year. After a long, enjoyable stroll, the Schloss-Café offers fortification. Benrath's cosy town centre is also home to pleasant restaurants and cafés, as well as Bistro Kombu, which is probably the city's best Japanese snack bar.



Sufinary Craftsman

Foodies and culinary aficionados feel completely at home in Düsseldorf as it offers a huge range of traditional and handmade delicacies – including Japanese specialities, real artisanal bakery and a confectionery to die for.

Düsseldorf's culinary scene features a high density of award-winning restaurants, a large selection of international cuisine and cool cafés. The impressive dining spectrum, including nine gourmet establishments with Michelin stars, is by far not all the city has to offer. The Düsseldorf chocolatier, Heinemann, is one of Europe's leading companies of the confectioner's craft. Heinemann's champagne truffles are world famous. Heinemann creates sweet dreams from



You'll find the finest sushi and sashimi in Düsseldorf, prepared by Japanese masters of their craft. chocolate, nuts and champagne by hand and using the best ingredients – and the creations produced by senior partner and master confectioner Heinz-Richard Heinemann are to die for. It's even worth just to visit one of the three branches for their gorgeous and lavishly designed window displays.

The Hinkel family bakery enjoys a similar status. Master baker Josef Hinkel has won just about every award going with his traditional baking and even has held the title of "Baker of the Year." He still sells traditional bread made without yeast or other additives, but created by hand with great love, slow fermentation and using old recipes.

One very special culinary highlight is a visit to "Little Tokyo". There are around 7,000 Japanese nationals living in Düsseldorf. This means you'll find just about every Japanese delicacy from simple snack to award-winning restaurant dining. A particular treat here is the Restaurant Soba An. Fresh buckwheat noodles are made here every day – a tradition that is under threat even in Japan.

The brewery pubs in Düsseldorf are a haven of Rhenish joie de vivre. Strangers quickly become friends over an Altbier and and a few savoury snacks called Bierhappen.

Dark, top-fermented Altbier is a Düsseldorf speciality beer. It is brewed in small breweries with adjoining pubs, hidden away in Düsseldorf's Altstadt (Old Town). So it is served absolutely fresh in small beer glasses. You won't find a more local and traditionally brewed beer than that! Guests sit together cosily on long wooden benches in the old hostelries. That makes it easy to start talking to the person beside you while enjoying a tasty "Alt". Traditional dishes such as Rhenish Sauerbraten or blood sausage with mashed potato are served. If you just fancy something light, try the Bierhappen, savoury snacks that go perfectly with a tasty Altbier. Incidentally, Altbier doesn't have its name because it's "alt" (old") but because it is brewed in the old traditional way.

Düsseldorf is not only the state capital but also the cultural capital, because it is home to world-class museums, exhibitions, opera and theatre. Then there's the city's long artistic tradition.

Art and culture are visible everywhere in the Düsseldorf cityscape – they are an essential part of the city's DNA. Düsseldorf's roots as an art metropolis date back to 1690 and Elector Johann Wilhelm, affectionately known as Jan Wellem. This enlightened ruler and his wife, Anna Maria Luisa de' Medici, made the then sleepy town on the Rhine into a centre of art and culture. Today, with its many museums, galleries and art in public spaces, Düsseldorf still occupies a special position because nowhere else is an involvement with art so deeply rooted as here.

The Kunstsammlung NRW shows 20th and 21st century art, the Kunsthalle's ultra-modern exhibitions have their finger on the pulse, the NRW-Forum specialises in contemporary photography, while the Kunstpalast is worth a visit simply to see the temporary exhibitions and a Rubens collection that was created by Jan Wellem. The paintings, graphic art, sculptures and glass objects in the museum's collection range from the ancient world to the 21st century. Visitors have a chance to assess the future development of contemporary art at the annual tour of the renowned Kunstakademie. This is where tomorrow's stars of the art scene are on show.

The "in orbit" installation by Tomás Saraceno at the K21 Ständehaus is very interesting, particularly for youngsters. Some 2,500 square metres of transparent steel nets extend high above the piazza. It is not only the visual but also the performing arts that are represented in Düsseldorf. At the beautiful Tonhalle there are regular concerts by composers ranging from Bach to Beethoven, and Brahms to Bruckner. The Deutsche Oper am Rhein is famed both for its operas and its highly acclaimed ballet company. At the Tanzhaus NRW too, one can see dance of the highest standard. In addition, the Schauspielhaus is considered to be one of the leading German-language theatres. And with the new Wehrhahn line, Düsseldorf has even turned underground stations into works of art.

Family fun

Fancy doing something with the kids? That's no problem in Düsseldorf either. There is a huge choice of child-friendly excursions and a few of the destinations are pretty unique as well. A number of leisure parks are also within easy reach.

You'll find the Wildpark Grafenberg game reserve in the forest above the city. Nestling in 40 hectares of grounds in the middle of a 200-year-old beech forest, more than one hundred animals live in spacious enclosures. They include species such as red deer, foxes, wild cats and mouflon sheep. Some of them roam the reserve freely, so children can feed the deer and maybe even get to stroke them. And by the way, a visit to this picturesque game reserve is free of charge. Visitors can admire marine flora and fauna at Aquazoo Löbbecke Museum. More than 500 animal species are on show in aquariums, terrariums and a tropical hall in an area of 6,800 square metres. The biggest funfair on the Rhine takes place every year in July. The many rides are sure to bring a smile to children's faces. The nearby Phantasialand, Movie Park, the 150,000 square metre Alpenpark Neuss, which contains not only ski slopes but also other leisure activities like a high rope and adventure golf course and more. Further amusement parks are open all year round.

Prof. Dr. Stephan Martin: Thanks to the University Hospital, we have a training and research location in Düsseldorf that has an impact on the entire range of medical services offered in the city. After all, the best graduates settle here or continue working at the city's many clinics. The clinics are highly specialised; for example, there are renowned centres for cardiology, orthopaedics, heart surgery and diabetology.



Ole Friedrich: In addition to the excellent medical care, Düsseldorf also offers an equally outstanding range of top-class hotels. This is also a significant aspect for our international patients. In addition, there is an exciting restaurant scene, world-class shopping, a cultural offer with internationally renowned museums, opera and theatres. The Mercer study regularly places Düsseldorf in the top 10 of the world's most liveable cities. In the current study, the city came in sixth place.

Prof. Dr. Stephan Martin: It is precisely this quality of life in Düsseldorf that our patients repeatedly point out to us. When I say that someone should stay longer in the city for treatment, the answer often comes back: "It doesn't matter, we feel very comfortable here. What we also hear again and again is that our patients very much appreciate the Rhine promenade with its view of the majestic river Rhine and relaxing walks through the Hofgarten. The ambience and the way of life that we cultivate in the city make it very easy for visitors to quickly feel at home.




