- 1.4. Service Partners, service providers or providers of the services promised by MeineCardPlus are neither RMN nor hosts, unless it is their own range of services.
- 1.5. The term "Host" below refers to commercial accommodation providers, vacation rental owners and private landlords who participate in the MeineCardPlus program and make MeineCardPlus available to the guest.
- 1.6. The guest who receives MeineCardPlus from their Host and to whom it is specifically issued is hereinafter referred to as the "Cardholder". The Cardholder is entitled to use the services promised by MeineCardPlus.
- 1.7. All guests of the participating Host are entitled to use it. Travelling children up to the age of 3 are entitled to the card services of the Service Partner free of charge, provided that the adult accompanying the child as a Cardholder provides proof of entitlement. Family members of Cardholders of the Host and their families who are registered with their primary residence in the same household are not entitled to use.
- 1.8. The "Service Period" of MeineCardPlus extends to the entire duration of the guest's stay with the Host. The validity of MeineCardPlus is limited to the number of usage days (from midnight to midnight) per overnight stay. It begins when the Host issues the card on the day of arrival and ends at midnight on the day of departure.

2. Legal basis, service obligations of Service Partners, relationship between card services and other services provided by Service Partners, information and assurances from third parties

- 2.1. The issuance and use of MeineCardPlus does not create any contractual obligation between the Cardholder and the Hosts or RMN with regard to the services of the Service Partners.
The Hosts themselves do not have any contractual obligations towards the Cardholder with regard to the services of the Service Partners, neither as a primary contractual obligation nor as a secondary contractual obligation. The same applies to RMN as issuer of MeineCardPlus. In particular, Hosts and RMN do not have the status of a package tour operator or travel agent. By using the card, the contractual relationship between the Cardholder as a guest of the Host and the agreements made with the Host regarding the use of the accommodation and other services remain unaffected.
- 2.2. The agreement with the Cardholder for the service is concluded with the respective provider (Service Partner) of the service. All Service Partners are listed in detail in the MeineCardPlus list of services, the so-called "Leisure Guide", which the Cardholder receives from the Host upon handover of the MeineCardPlus card and which is available on the website: <http://www.MeineCardPlus.de>. Only the relevant Service Partner is obliged to provide the relevant service to the Cardholder, not RMN or the Host, unless it concerns their own offers.
- 2.3. In terms of the services, solely the respective Service Partner as provider is the contracting party. RMN and the Hosts are not obliged to provide any information or assurances with regard to the MeineCardPlus services, unless the Host is also a Service Partner. RMN and the Host are not liable for service and price information, the services themselves, or for personal or property damage in connection with the provision of services.
- 2.4. The contractual and service relationship between the Cardholder and the Service Partner for the services promised with MeineCardPlus is governed, in addition to these Terms and Conditions of Card Use, by the General Terms and Conditions and/or Service or Transport Terms and Conditions of the Service Partner as the provider, as well as by the legal provisions applicable to the respective service relationship, to the extent that these have been effectively agreed or are generally applicable under the law.
- 2.5. The services promised by MeineCardPlus in accordance with the current list of services are not the main tourist services within the scope of other contractual services provided by the Host or RMN. Therefore, the Host and RMN do not have the status of a package tour operator as defined by law with respect to the card services, unless the services, together with other services provided by the Host, constitute a package of travel services in accordance with the principles of Section 651a (2) of the German Civil Code (BGB) or are expressly offered by the Provider as such.
- 2.6. The Hosts are not authorized by RMN to make agreements that deviate from these Terms and Conditions of Use, to provide information or to make assurances that deviate from, contradict or go beyond the current list of services of MeineCardPlus. The same applies to Service Partners, unless the information, deviating agreement or assurance relates to their own service.

3. Conclusion of the Card Usage Agreement, issuance of the card, no charge

- 3.1. With the offer of the actual issuance of MeineCardPlus, RMN, represented by the Hosts, offers the Cardholder the conclusion of a Card Usage Agreement based on these Terms and Conditions of Use and the current list of services. The Card Usage Agreement with the Cardholder based on these Terms and Conditions of Use shall come into effect upon the Cardholder's receipt of MeineCardPlus. By accepting MeineCardPlus, the Cardholder accepts these Terms and Conditions of Card Use.
- 3.2. RMN as the issuer of MeineCardPlus merely organizes and manages the card system and obligates the affiliated Service Partners to provide the service to the Cardholder.
In addition to MeineCardPlus in paper form, the Cardholder may use MeineCardPlus Digital, see Section 4. The QR code on both MeineCardPlus and MeineCardPlus Digital provides up-to-date information on the data stored on MeineCardPlus, such as places visited, first and last name, card number, and arrival and departure dates and, if applicable, travel companions.
- 3.3. Both MeineCardPlus and MeineCardPlus Digital are provided free of charge to Cardholders.

4. MeineCardPlus – Card activation at <https://erlebnis.meinecardplus.de>, Cardholder responsibilities

- 4.1. In order to use the digital card, the Cardholder must register at <https://erlebnis.meinecardplus.de> and provide the required information.
- 4.2. There is no entitlement to the activation of MeineCardPlus Digital. The Cardholder may only use MeineCardPlus Digital if they have previously accepted the Terms and Conditions of Use upon receipt of MeineCardPlus. When activating MeineCardPlus Digital at <http://erlebnis.meinecardplus.de>, the Cardholder will be reminded of these Terms and Conditions of Card Use.
- 4.3. The Cardholder is obliged to use their full surname (real name), the code provided and, if applicable, their MeineCardPlus card number for registration during activation. The true identity of the User must be identifiable to RMN as the provider of the website. The real name is not visible to other users or third parties. (However, each Cardholder may display accompanying family/group members with their own cards in the digital representation).
We also refer to the website's privacy (data protection) policy, which the user accepts when activating MeineCardPlus Digital at <http://erlebnis.meinecardplus.de>.
- 4.4. The provider of the Progressive Web App (PWA) erlebnis.meinecardplus.de does not guarantee that the content provided on the website is correct, complete or up-to-date at all times.
- 4.5. The Cardholder may not grant third parties access to the Cardholder's personal MeineCardPlus Digital. The Cardholder is obliged to keep their access data and card number confidential and to protect them from access by third parties (with the exception of accompanying guests).
- 4.6. The Cardholder may revoke their consent by cancelling the declaration of consent in the login area. This will result in the erasure of the user data for MeineCardPlus Digital, and the functionality of the digital MeineCardPlus will cease to exist. However, the Cardholder may continue to use the printed MeineCardPlus.
- 4.7. Upon expiration of the MeineCardPlus service period, access to MeineCardPlus Digital in the PWA will be automatically terminated. It will no longer be possible to log in. This will result in the erasure of the user data for MeineCardPlus Digital.
- 4.8. In the event of good cause, such as a serious breach of these Terms and Conditions of Card Use, RMN, as the provider, is entitled to block the Cardholder's access to the www.grimmheimat.de website and MeineCardPlus Digital immediately and without notice.
- 4.9. Adjustment or modification of <http://erlebnis.meinecardplus.de>
 - 4.9.1. RMN is entitled to make changes to the Progressive Web App erlebnis.meinecardplus.de at any time.
 - 4.9.2. RMN is entitled to terminate its service with MeineCardPlus Digital with a notice period of two weeks. In the event of termination of MeineCardPlus Digital, RMN is entitled, but not obliged, to erase all content created by users.

5. Type, scope and limitations of services, exclusion from use; term of MeineCardPlus

- 5.1. After receiving MeineCardPlus, the Cardholder may use the services listed in the current list of services of MeineCardPlus. The type and scope of services provided to the Cardholder are determined exclusively by the list of services valid at the time the card is issued, which is handed over to the Cardholder together with MeineCardPlus or is generally announced or made known.
- 5.2. The Service Partners are obliged to provide the services on the basis of the general terms and conditions of their business activities, in particular taking into account the specified service times, opening hours and general service conditions (e.g., weather conditions).
- 5.3. Insofar as the services of MeineCardPlus are described in advertising materials (such as host directories, brochures, catalogues, websites) outside the currently valid list of services for the free MeineCardPlus, the service description in the currently valid list of services for MeineCardPlus shall apply exclusively to the use of these services by the Cardholder. This applies in particular if the description in the MeineCardPlus list of services differs from other service descriptions.
- 5.4. The Service Partners may restrict the advertised services in whole or in part, in particular in terms of time, if there are good reasons for doing so. Such reasons may include, but are not limited to, weather conditions, government regulations or orders, maintenance and repairs, traffic safety measures, excessive crowds or overcrowding of facilities, and other similar valid reasons.
- 5.5. RMN as publisher and Service Partner has the right to partially or completely, temporarily or permanently exclude Cardholders and other authorized users from use if they do not meet specific personal requirements (e.g., health requirements or requirements regarding clothing and equipment) or if their specific use poses a risk to the Cardholder, third parties or the facilities of the service partner. The same applies if the Cardholder violates legal regulations, safety regulations, usage regulations or instructions of supervisory personnel during use, or if the Cardholder behaves in such a way that exclusion is objectively justified.
- 5.6. The Cardholder shall have no claims against MeineCardPlus in the event of a restriction of services pursuant to Sections 5.4. or 5.5 or a justified exclusion pursuant to Section 5.5.
- 5.7. The services of MeineCardPlus may only be used during the Cardholder's stay at a participating Host within the geographical scope of MeineCardPlus as specified in Section 1.11. There is no right to transfer MeineCardPlus and/or its services to future stays or other persons.

6. Use of MeineCardPlus, obligations and liability of the Cardholder

- 6.1. In order to use the services, the Cardholder must present MeineCardPlus in its original paper form or display MeineCardPlus Digital on a device and present it to the Service Partner for electronic or visual verification prior to using the service.
- 6.2. Users of MeineCardPlus Digital are responsible for ensuring that their device has sufficient battery power for verification.
- 6.3. In addition, the MeineCardPlus Digital Cardholder is responsible for ensuring that their device has Internet access. Only then can they display MeineCardPlus Digital on their device to facilitate verification before using the services. If they are unable to do so for technical reasons, the Service Partner may refuse to provide the service. This also applies in the event of a defective device or a lack of local Internet access due to regional conditions. Service Partners are under no obligation to provide Wi-Fi or devices to Cardholders. RMN therefore recommends carrying MeineCardPlus in paper form as an additional measure.
- 6.4. Upon request, the Cardholder is obliged to present a valid photo ID. If the Cardholder is unable to do so, the Service Partner may refuse to provide the service. For age-related services and benefits for the Cardholder or their eligible family members, the Service Partner may request proof of age.
- 6.5. In the event of theft, loss or damage of the MeineCardPlus, the Cardholder is obliged to report the incident immediately to the Host so that the Host can block MeineCardPlus. The Cardholder shall receive a new MeineCardPlus from the Host free of charge for the service period.
- 6.6. The Cardholder shall be liable to RMN or the Host and the Service Partners for any damage resulting from the Cardholder's own or a third party's misuse of MeineCardPlus if the Cardholder is culpably causally responsible or co-responsible for such misuse.
- 6.7. In case of misuse or suspicion of misuse, the Service Partners are authorized to note the card number of MeineCardPlus as well as the first and last name and to forward this information to RMN in order to initiate the blocking of MeineCardPlus by RMN.
- 6.8. In case of suspicion of misuse of MeineCardPlus by third parties, the Cardholder is obliged to report this immediately to their Host.
- 6.9. MeineCardPlus does not provide any insurance cover. It is the Cardholder's responsibility to check and ensure that they have sufficient insurance cover, in particular for accidents related to the use of card services and for repatriation costs in the event of accident or illness.
- 6.10. It is the Cardholder's responsibility to independently evaluate and meet the personal qualifications and requirements, especially with regard to health and government regulations, which are a prerequisite for using the card services.

7. Technical obligations of RMN

- 7.1. RMN makes every effort to keep the technical system behind MeineCardPlus available at all times. However, the Cardholder has no entitlement to the continuous availability of the service, such as the PWA <https://erlebnis.meinecardplus.de>. Maintenance work may result in the temporary unavailability of the service (barcode on MeineCardPlus) and the website www.grimmheimat.de. RMN recommends that the Cardholder also carry MeineCardPlus in paper form as an additional measure.
- 7.2. Due to the structure of the Internet, RMN has no influence on Internet data transmission and assumes no responsibility for the availability, reliability and quality of telecommunications networks, data networks and technical facilities of third parties outside its own communications network. RMN is not responsible for disruptions on account of force majeure.
- 7.3. RMN is not responsible for the security and continuity of data transmission over third party communication networks, such as Internet Service Providers, and is not responsible for interruptions in data transmission caused by technical errors or configuration issues on the part of the Cardholder.

8. Dispute resolution

- 8.1. The European Commission provides a platform for out-of-court dispute resolution (Art. 14 para. 1 of the ODR Regulation). This allows consumers to resolve disputes without first going to court. The dispute resolution platform can be accessed via the following link: <https://ec.europa.eu/consumers/odr/>.

9. Reservation of the right to make changes to the card services and Terms and Conditions of Card Use

- 9.1. RMN as the issuer of MeineCardPlus and the Service Partners as service providers reserve the right to amend these Terms and Conditions of Card Use and the list of services from time to time for objective reasons and to adapt these documents to technical and legal developments.
- 9.2. The Cardholder is bound by the version of the Terms and Conditions of Card Use and the list of services known at the time of issuance of MeineCardPlus. Changes after the issue of MeineCardPlus are excluded for the period of validity relevant to the respective Cardholder if they are detrimental to the Cardholder.
- 9.3. In addition, the General Terms and Conditions of the Service Partners as providers shall apply to the extent that they have been validly agreed and contain permissible provisions in this regard; otherwise, they shall apply in accordance with the statutory provisions.

10. Information on data processing

- 10.1. The Cardholder is informed that their name, the duration of the stay (=validity period) and the accommodating Host of the Cardholder are stored and processed by RMN on MeineCardPlus for the purpose of providing and monitoring the service and can be read by the Service Partners for monitoring purposes. The Cardholder can exercise their rights as a data subject under the GDPR, in particular the right to information and the right to object to data processing, at any time vis-à-vis RMN. However, it is not possible to use the MeineCardPlus services without processing these data. RMN's privacy (data protection) policy is available on the Internet at www.grimmheimat.de/datenschutz and can be viewed and provided by participating Hosts upon request.

11. Choice of law

- 11.1. The entire legal and contractual relationship between RMN and the Cardholder in connection with the Card Usage Agreement and between the Cardholder and the Service Partner in connection with the contractual and usage relationship for the respective services shall be governed exclusively by the laws of the Federal Republic of Germany.
- 11.2. Mandatory consumer protection regulations of the EU country in which a Cardholder as consumer from another EU country has their habitual residence shall remain unaffected by the choice of law under Section 10.1.

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
