

100-year history as a garrison town.






Schwarzwälder Freilichtmuseum Vogtsbauernhof

ensures an eventful visit to the museum during the entire season: cooking demonstrations in the tradi-

tional kitchen, daily mill demonstrations, free tours across the museum's grounds, craft demonstrations and numerous exciting event highlights are scheduled. The wide range of hands-on activities on offer make the museum especially attractive for families with children. For instance, young guests can participate in the varied hands-on programme each Sunday and during holiday periods in Baden-Württemberg. The museum workshop, which is open every day, gives young people the chance to construct various workpieces from wood under expert guidance. 

Aussichtsturm Urenkopf The "Urenkopfturm", with its slender form and 183 2.8 km. The path leads along a small stream, more of a rivulet, but still a gorge for children, which they can cross with the help of ropes. A range of balancing stations line the path. It also contains a barbecue hut. From here, it is worth taking a short detour to the "Kreuzbergkapelle" chapel with its stunning view over the Kinzigtal. The tower can only be reached on foot via a number of different routes; the shortest path takes you from the "Wanderparkplatz Urenkopfturm" (B294) to the destination in 25 minutes, while the path via the HI, fountain with its miniature water mills provides an interesting route.

Towers to climb can be ound outside the town centre: the 30 m-high 'Auf der Wanne' viewing tower promises a unique vantage point for conquerors with a head for heights. The 'Hubenloch' park, situated outside the historic Villingen town centre, is equipped with fantastic playgrounds and a 25 m-high viewing tower that offers a magnificent panoramic view over the town's rooftops. Just as worthwhile is a visit to chwenningen, once the watchmaking capital of the world. The 'Schwenninger Moos' nature eserve is home to the source of the Neckar and provides a magical landscape at any time of year. his is where a huge number of bird species have their breeding and nesting places. 
