**Visitor mine pit: Grube Wenzel – Treasures hidden deep underground**

In the "Grube Wenzel" exhibition mine in Oberwolfach, you will discover one of the most important silver mines in the central Black Forest. Young and old visitors receive a unique insight into the historic mine and can access numerous secrets.

Knowledgeable mine guides show you the traces of historic and more recent mining and also tell you about the active mine in Grube Clara in Oberwolfach.

Equipped with helmet, miner's lamp, boots and jacket, explores both young and old are taken into the depths of the mine with its tunnels of considerable size and rich treasures.

Two "Grube Wenzel" tours are available:

- The "Entdecken tour" (duration: approx. 1.5 hours, approx. 1,000 m of accessible route, suitable for children)
- The "Erfahren tour" (duration: approx. 3 hours, approx. 2,300 m of accessible route through the upper and lower sections, from 14 years, only possible with registration)

After the tour, traditional boot washing at the fountain is naturally also included in the visit to the mine.
